Welcome to our School...

Old Hutton VC CE Primary is a small church school, proud to be graded an 'Outstanding' school by Ofsted (Feb 2016) and 'Outstanding' in all aspects as a church school by SIAMS (Oct 2015). Our pupil results are consistently high compared to other schools locally and nationally, including being in the top 1% of schools for our Y6 achievement, 2017. We are situated in an area of great natural beauty just outside the Lake District National Park in South Cumbria. The roll, currently 92 pupils, is divided between 4 classes, Early Years Foundation Stage, Key Stage 1 (Y1/2), Lower Key Stage 2 (Y3/4) and Upper Key Stage 2 (Y5/6). The school serves the villages of Old and New Hutton and surrounding rural areas. Many pupils travel from outside the catchment area, including the nearby towns of Kendal and Kirkby Lonsdale. We are a National Support School (NSS) and our head teacher is a National Leader of Education (NLE), which means that we actively support other schools, sharing our good practice and contributing to the wider self-improving school system. We benefit from being part of 2 local collaborations of schools: the KCP (Kendal Collaborative Partnership) and Milnthorpe Small Schools' Consortium. We have very active links with 2 French-speaking schools, L'Ecole Joachim Fode N'Diaye in Joal, Senegal (for whom we also fundraise) and L'Ecole de la Visitation in Marseille, France.
