<p>If you have returned from the following specific areas <b>since 19th February</b>, you should <b>call NHS 111</b> to inform them of your recent travel and stay indoors and avoid contact with other people, <b>even if you do not have symptoms:</b></p>	<p>If you have returned from the following areas since 19 February and develop symptoms, however mild, you should stay indoors at home and avoid contact with other people immediately and call NHS 111:</p>	<p>If you have a cough, or fever or shortness of breath and have visited any of the following areas in the last 14 days, stay indoors and call NHS 111 informing them of your recent travel:</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Iran</li> <li>• Specific lockdown areas in Northern Italy: the Lombardy and Veneto regions (defined by a line above, and not including, Pisa, Florence and Rimini)</li> <li>• Special care zones in South Korea (Daegu or Cheongdo)</li> <li>• Hubei province in China (returned in the past 14 days)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Northern Italy (see details in column on left)</li> <li>• Vietnam</li> <li>• Cambodia</li> <li>• Laos</li> <li>• Myanmar</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• China, apart from Hubei province</li> <li>• Thailand</li> <li>• Japan</li> <li>• Republic of Korea, apart from special care zones</li> <li>• Hong Kong</li> <li>• Taiwan</li> <li>• Singapore</li> <li>• Malaysia</li> <li>• Macau</li> </ul>

These areas are subject to change, please keep checking the Government guidance for updates.
