# Parent

Parent/Carer.....

## To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- I will check my child's health daily: temperature and signs of COVID-19 or any other illness.
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will begin to self-isolate for 10 days as a family, I will get them tested (via NHS 119) and I will let the school know as soon as possible about my child's symptoms of illness and test result.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately when informed and get them tested.
- I will follow instructions to keep my child at home and isolate them (and the rest of our family if needed) for 10 days if required to by school/NHS/ NHS Test and Trace.
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules, observing the routes marked out around the school site.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- I will wash my child's clothes worn for school regularly and send them in PE kit on PE days.
- My child will not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school, apart from clean lunchbox, water bottle, coat/hat and reading book/s or other homework as organised by their class teacher.
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment made via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- I agree to the approach set out in the school planning/risk assessment letter.

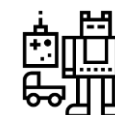
## I will do my best to:
